Go first to Sennett Hall to check in, and then to dinner at 5 O'Clock P.M. UM-Machias will provide dormitory room space for \$3.00 per person, the Friday evening meal for \$2.00, Saturday breakfast for \$1.50 and a packed lunch for Saturday for \$1.50. 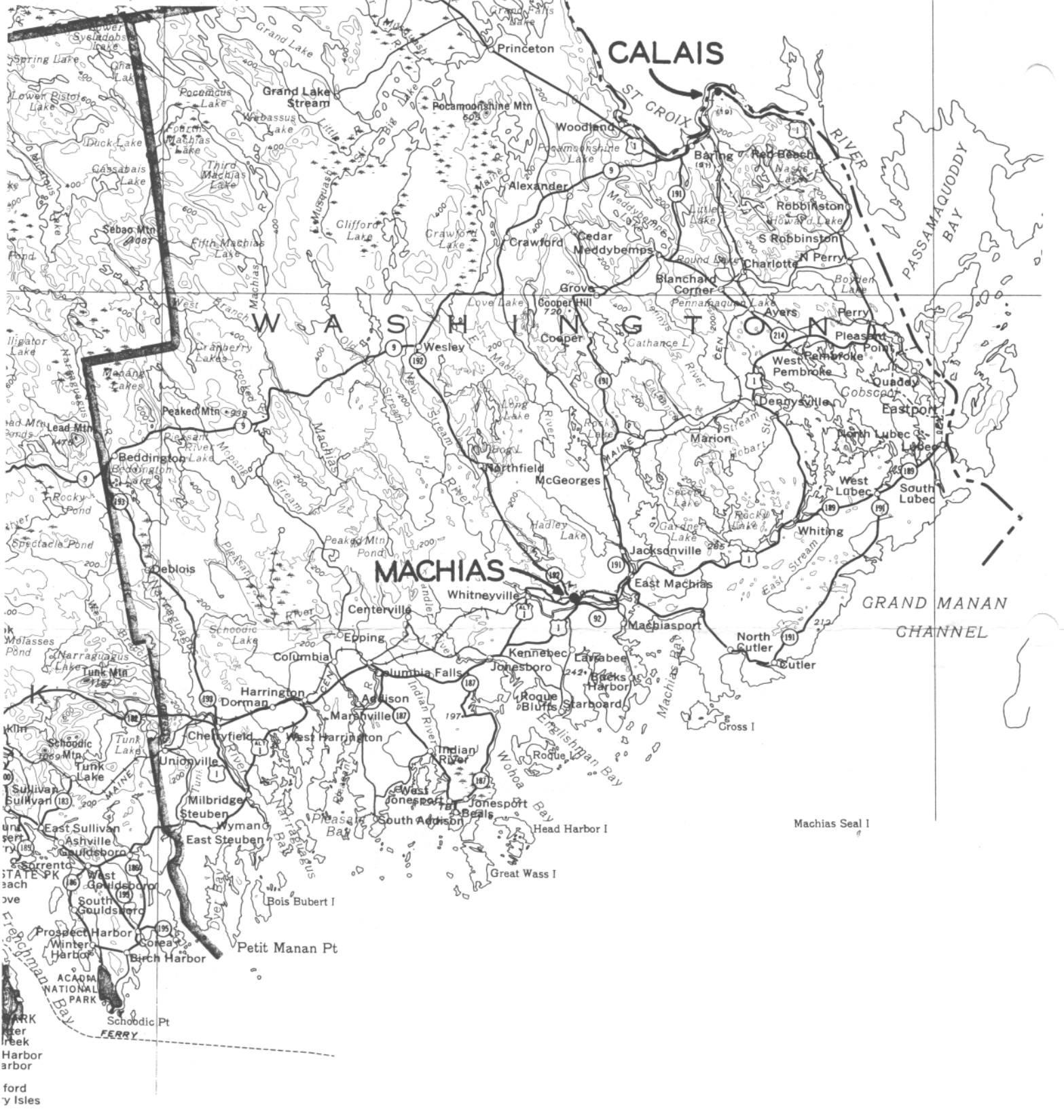
